

## Crib Certification

All our cribs are CPSC Compliant, (Consumer Products Safety Commission) w/ Federal Regulations 16CFR 1508. Our El Greco cribs, #'s 864, 865, 872 & 4703, are Certified by Bureau Veritas which is a 3<sup>rd</sup> part testing lab who tests in accordance with American Society of Testing & Materials.

## In response to the questions that consumers may have in light of the Federal crib regulation announcement:

“El Greco has not had a recall on any of our drop side cribs. Although there have been serious issues in the marketplace with some hardware used for drop side operation, we have not used it on the products we manufacture.

The government adoption of the ASTM standard that voluntarily eliminated drop sides last year, will take effect in **mid June of 2011**. At that time, it will become against the law to place drop side cribs into the stream of commerce, but it will not be against the law to use them in your home. The sweeping scope of the new law is meant to close any loop holes that would allow more of the imports that caused all the problems to come into the marketplace.

You bought a high quality, domestically made crib and can continue to use it with confidence. If your crib is not working properly for some reason, please let us know and we can address any issue. As always and with any crib, be sure to tighten all bolts regularly.

Again, as long as your crib is operating properly and you still have all hardware for it, you need not take any action in light of the recent regulatory change.”

The Drop side cribs can be left as drop side cribs or you can choose to convert an El Greco Drop Side Crib to a Stationary Side Crib. El Greco and Relics have worked together to develop a method of converting a Drop Side Crib to a Stationary Side Crib. It involves installing 2 “L” brackets and predrilling 4 holes and installing 4 screws. The brackets are antique bronze and can be installed in a way that is slightly visible, or 100% concealed. The concealed way is a little bit more difficult being that the area where the brackets will be going will be harder to access, but it is possible.
